PUTNAM PARK RULES

1. For all race events, the paved area between the hot pits and the tower is for staging and tech and is not to be used as a paddock.
2. Do not work on vehicles on black top roads.
3. Keep all canopy poles off black top roads.
4. If gas, oil, or solvents are spilled, please clean up as soon as possible. The track will provide oil-dry to dry up any spills.
5. Dump waste oil into 55-gallon drums marked "oil".
6. Fuel containers are not allowed on the racetrack. Fueling must be done in the pits or paddock only.
7. Bicycles, mini-bikes, scooters and all-terrain vehicles are not permitted on walkways, the driveway to the tower, the grass hill or the staging area.
8. Do not start engines before 8:00 a.m.
9. Do not stand in the pits or staging area east of the yellow line.
10. Do not leave old tires or parts on the property. [You will be charged \$10/tire.]
11. Pets must be leashed or tethered at all times and are not allowed on any paved area.
12. No alcohol is to be consumed on the property until the track is closed.
[5:00 p.m. Friday and Sunday; 6:00 p.m. Saturday.]
13. Firearms and fireworks are not allowed on the property.
14. No climbing or jumping any fences.
15. Do not leave small children unattended.
16. BF Goodrich Scorcher T/A or similar color treaded tires are banned at Putnam Park. Colored (other than black) marks will be removed at a charge of \$100 per linear foot.
17. Track management reserves the right to expel and/or ban individuals in violation of any rule.

SELECTED ADDITIONAL RULES AS DEFINED BY TRACK CONTRACT

1. All vehicles must have a muffler in working order to participate.
2. Participants, their guests and crew agree to vacate the facility before 6:00 p.m. on Friday, before 7:00 p.m. on Saturday and before 6:00 p.m. on Sunday.
IMPORTANT: Any violation of this rule will result in the participant being charged \$250.00 per hour or any part thereof.
3. OVERNIGHT CAMPLING IS NOT ALLOWED AT PUTNAM PARK.

BLUEGRASS BIMMERS [FRIDAY] DRIVING SCHOOL RULES HIGHLIGHTS

1. CLOTHING: Long-sleeved shirts, long pants and tennis or running shoes are recommended. However, due to the possibility of high temperatures/humidity, short sleeved shirts and short pants are permissible at the driver's discretion.
2. WAIVER: You must sign the CLUB waiver, and you, and any passenger, must have the appropriate armband prior to entering the pits. These are only available from the Race Chair who will be available in the paddock between track sessions. Plan ahead, or lose your track session when track control sends you back for armband(s).
3. PASSENGERS: An instructor may ride in your car, if it has a passenger seat and restraints (seat belts) equal to those of the driver. If you are an instructor you may ride in another car, if it has a passenger seat and equal restraints .
4. ENTERING THE TRACK: Pull to the end of the pit lane and wait until you are signaled to enter. Watch for cars coming up the front straight, and point them by on the right as necessary.
IMPORTANT: This is the only time that cars may pass on the right. See PASSING below.
5. PASSING: All passing is on the LEFT and only between Turns 10 and 1, 4 and 5, 7 and 8, and 8 and 9. Passing is only allowed when a clear signal (arm out the window so corner workers can see it) is given by the car being overtaken. You MUST likewise give a pass signal to a faster car behind you. Corner workers will assume that a car on your bumper through several turns is either faster than you or that you are racing. If you pass without a signal, fail to give a signal, make a late pass (in a turn) or appear to be racing, you will be black-flagged and required to come into the pits.
6. PITS: The pits are NOT hot. Speed limit is 15 mph. There is to be no fueling or working on cars in the pits.
7. BLACK FLAGS: Return to the pits immediately. If you ignore a black flag you will lose the rest of your Friday sessions. Unlike racing, under DRIVING SCHOOL RULES, spinning and/or other off-track excursions are black-flag offenses. Save yourself some track time: come into the pits, do your penance and return to the track.
8. NO RACING: Friday is a practice session under DRIVING SCHOOL RULES. If corner workers deem that you are racing you will be black-flagged and will lose the rest of your track sessions for that day.
